IMPORTANT

- **Monday morning:** Students are required to wear tracksuits or shorts and T-shirts for sports activities. Those not wearing trainers will not be allowed in. Locker rooms will be provided for those desiring to change.
- **Monday afternoon:** Both visits will be in French translated by English teachers on site
- **Tuesday morning:** a small drawing to be completed will be handed out to groups of students to write down the springs 'names and essential information
- **Tuesday afternoon:** the cakes and biscuits will be tasted the following day.
- **Wednesday and Thursday mornings:** Remind students to behave at all times and to listen to the English-speaking guides provided to their benefits and organised on their behalf.
- **Thursday afternoon:** Those who do not take part in the kayaking may want to linger on in town and meet us up at the train station for the return journey
Kayaking: Students are reminded to bring another complete set of clothes in a rucksack in case the boat overturns or if they want to change. Bring preferably discarded and worn-out clothes. They may also change after having sweated it out. Shower facilities will be available on site at the kayaking club.
- **Friday evening:** The disco will stop at 11.30; students will sweep the floor and clean the premises before leaving by 12.00.
