Day dedicated to the environment

We walked through the village of Kralovice that won awards for its land management and recovery after the end of mining in the area.

For example, a horse trail has been set up to enable horse-riders to go from Germany straight to Austria.

After lunch at the school cafétéria we went to the site of Lidice, a village that was burnt down by Nazi troops after the killing of a German military leader by the Czech. The men were killed and the women and children deported to camps. Only a few children survived and came back.

We were then driven through a vast disused steel-industry site in Kladno that cannot be dismantled because it is highly toxic.

We also visited an animal rescue centre where injured wild animals get cured before being released in a natural reserve. We saw sheep, geese, rabbits and owls.

Then we were given explanations about a low-energy building that welcomes children to teach them wildlife preservation.
