We learnt that each blade weighs 12 tons. It was the most important windfarm on the Czech Republik.



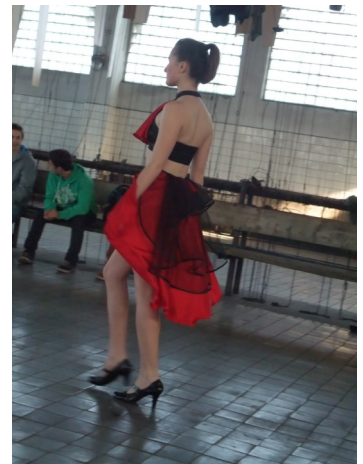
This mine was in use until 1997, when a methane explosion stopped its exploitation.
